The Anchor House is located in Kibbutz Ein Gev. Explore a variety of unique discoveries from the Sea of Galilee that provide insights into how they fished the Sea of Galilee - from biblical times to the present day.

The museum collection includes stone and iron anchors, stone fastenings, worshipping stones, and a variety of fishing nets. The museum's collection of photographs also provides a unique look at ancient harbors, the various fish that used to be prevalent in the lake, and other natural wonders from the area. A visit to the museum opens an amazing window to the hugely important fishing industry from around 3000 years ago.

#### **The Fruit House**


