Welcome To Ramada Jerusalem

The “Ramada Jerusalem” hotel is located by the southern entrance of Jerusalem. The hotel was originally built in 1984 as a congress hotel and resides on a territory of approximately a quarter of an acre.

The hotel’s rooms hold the scarce and breath taking urban view of Jerusalem. On the northern side the hotel faces the modern communities of Jerusalem bringing forth a new edge contrasting with the more ancient southern communities which preserve the unique mixture of cultures as the capital city. The location of the hotel enables easy access to the Government Complex, the Supreme Court, the Israel Museum and other attractions in the city.

Within close proximity of the hotel one can board the Jerusalem Light Rail, Citypass, which route’s passes through the Chord Bridge, Shuk Machne Yehuda (Jerusalem’s famous market, Jaffa Gate, and the northern neighbourhoods with maximum speed and comfort.

The hotel constitutes 360 rooms including suites, upgraded executive floors and an abundant of rooms allowing ideal accommodations for groups, families and couples.

The hotel also includes various event halls which can host small intimate meetings, special family occasions, large conferences, an active lobby, unique dairy and meat restaurants allowing even the observers of strict kashrus to enjoy from rich and plentiful choices.

The hotel consists of an indoor and an outdoor (May-Oct) pool, a modern gym, a wet and dry sauna. The hotel has 300 complimentary parking spaces in the hotel’s parking lot, a state of the art internet center (surcharges apply) which operates 24 hours a day, free wireless internet spread throughout the hotel.

Deluxe Room

Furnished in contemporary style, approximately 22 sqm, including a bathroom with the highest standards of finishing, the rooms are equipped with a desk, coffee table, 32 inch LCD screen including cable television, a safe deposit box, mini bar and hair dryer. In about 50% of the rooms, a shower stall is installed. All rooms are non-smoking and consist of a small smoking balcony which faces Jerusalem's urban view.



Family Room

Furnished modern style rooms, approximately 28 sqm, which include a bathroom with the highest standards of finishing, a sofa bed suitable for two children, a desk, and Coffee table, 32 inch LCD screen which includes cable television, a safe deposit box, min bar and hair dryer. All family rooms are non-smoking and have a small smoking balcony which faces the urban view of Jerusalem.

Junior Suite

The suite constitutes of two separate rooms, a deluxe room and another half room suitable for families with children that require two separate rooms. The suite has two separate bathrooms, a coffee/tea corner, a safe deposit box, 32 inch LCD screens and a mini bar.



Executive Suite

Is located on the 12th floor, the executive floor. The suite consists of two rooms which include a luxurious and spacious hosting room and a large sleeping room, a beautiful bathroom, a safe deposit box, coffee/tea corner and 32 inch LCD screens. It is possible to connect to an adjoining room through a connecting door. The furnishings and colors have been chosen carefully to the very last detail to enhance our guest's experience.

Honeymoon Suite

There are 3 identical suites on the 10th, 11th and 12th floors which are part of the hotel's executive floors. The suite consists of a large spacious room which in part of it has a sitting area, a large bed in another area, a safe deposit box, mini bar, coffee/tea corner, 42 inch LCD screen, a luxurious bathroom and a separate guest bathroom.



Panorama Suite

Located on the executive floor, 12th floor, this suite consists of two rooms and includes a balcony which faces the urban view of Jerusalem, a spacious bathroom, a large closet, safe deposit box, coffee/tea corner and 32 inch LCD screens. It is possible to connect to an adjoining room with a connecting door. The furnishings and colors have been chosen carefully to the very last detail to enhance our guest's experience.

Presidential Suite

Located on the executive floor, the 12th floor. The suite consists of two large rooms and includes a large balcony which faces a breathing view of Jerusalem. Executive Floor

The executive floor is located on the 11th and 12th floors which overlook the spectacular view of Jerusalem and offer the executive guest a chance to relish, all hours of the day, with a breath taking view, peace and quiet, luxurious and comfortable accommodations. The rooms are equipped with a desk, coffee table, wide beds with specially designed headboards, coffee and tea set, mini bar, safe deposit box, 32 inch LCD screen. Upon arrival, a sweet gift awaits the guest in addition to a robe and slippers for the use in the hotel.

The Dining Hall

The main dining hall is divided into two halls “David” and “Jonathan”. In the morning, a rich Israeli breakfast is served which include a varied and colourful salad bar, hard and soft cheeses, hot dishes and an array of rolls. Every evening a plentiful meat buffet is served with an abundant choices satisfying even the most discriminating of tastes. The dining hall can accommodate approximately 600 guests and can also be used as an event or convention hall.

The Ballroom

The Ballroom is located on the entrance main level and can hold, theatre style, approx. 1700 guests. This hall can be perfect for any type of occasion, such as grand wedding ceremonies as well as booths suitable for conventions. The construction of the hall enables it to be divided into 4 separate halls via acoustic walls that gives full separation between each hall. There is a lounge that connects the halls to a large area which can be used as an impressive reception and entry for the various halls.

- For additional charge one can use in the hotel a barco device and internet line.

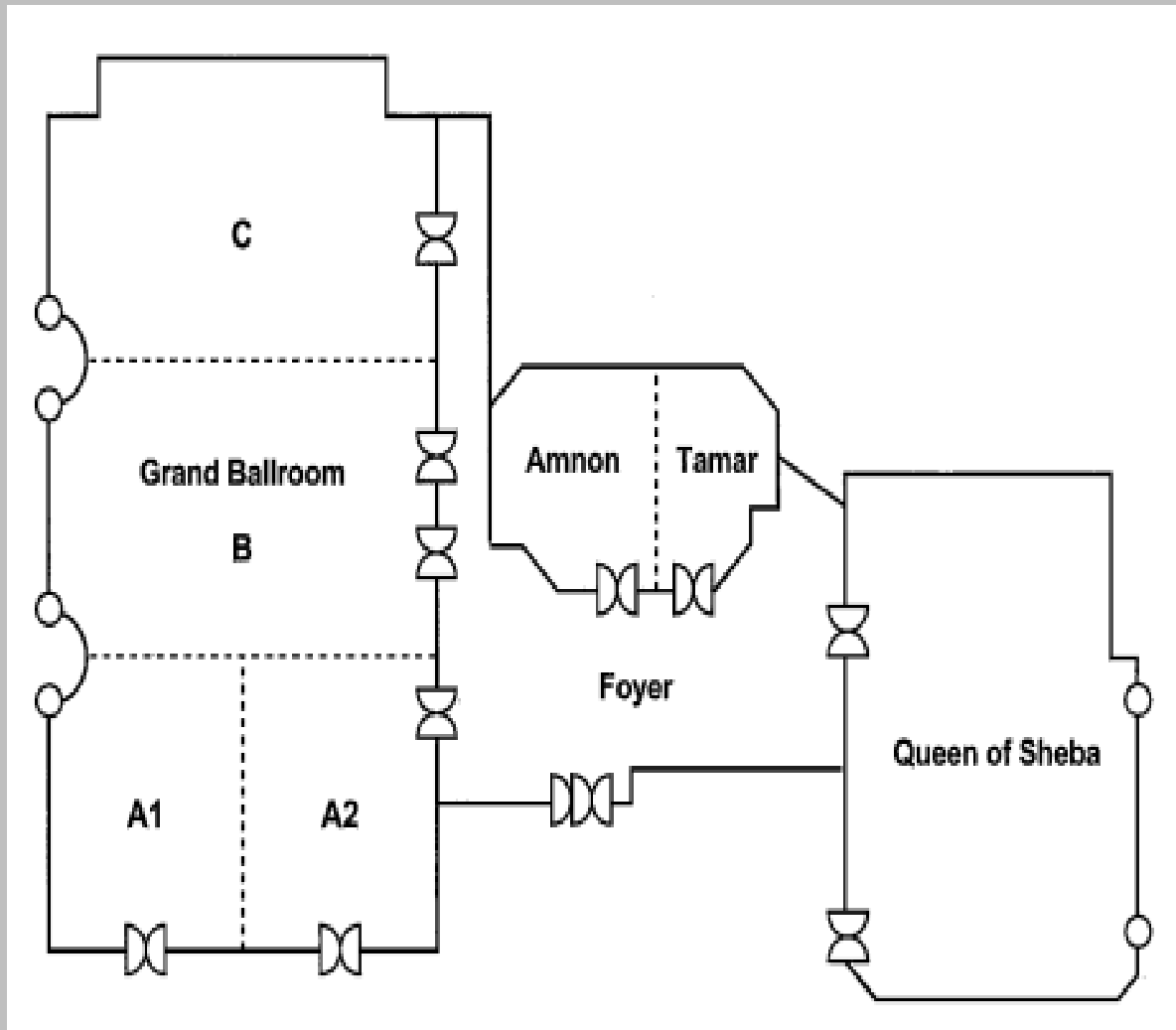
The Event Hall

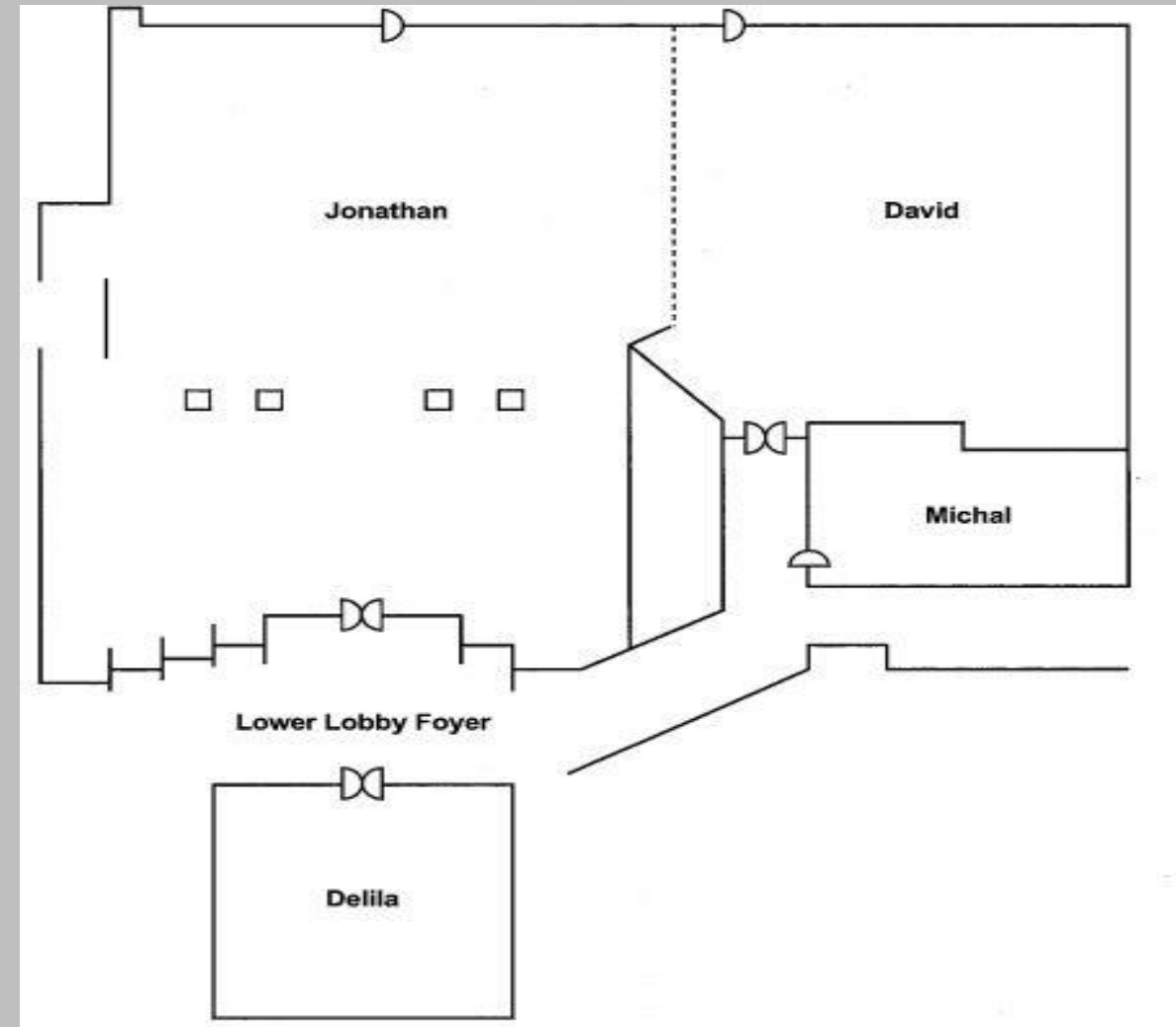

Breakfast

GYM

Dry sauna room and steam room (Turkish hammam) opens at same hours as the indoor pool, offers moments of inner peace and relaxation, free of charge for hotel guests.

INDOOR POOL

Our beautiful semi-olympic indoor swimming pool is designed for long-distance swimming or for a refreshing dip; open from Sunday-Thursday from 5:30 am-8:45 pm and on Friday from 6:00 am-6:00 pm. On Saturday and Jewish holidays the pool is open from 7:00am-8:45pm. Entrance is free for hotel guests.

OUTDOOR POOL

Our outdoor swimming pool features a spacious and well-maintained sun deck, spacious lawns and play areas for children and teenagers. The pool is designed for long-distance swim or refreshing dip, open from May to October on weekdays between the hours of 9:00 am-5:00 pm (flexible hours depending on daylight hours and time of the entry of Sabbath) free of charge for hotel guests.

TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURT

Adjacent to the outdoor pool and in a separate area, there is a modern tennis court and a basketball court for guests without extra charge.



Attractions near Ramada Jerusalem

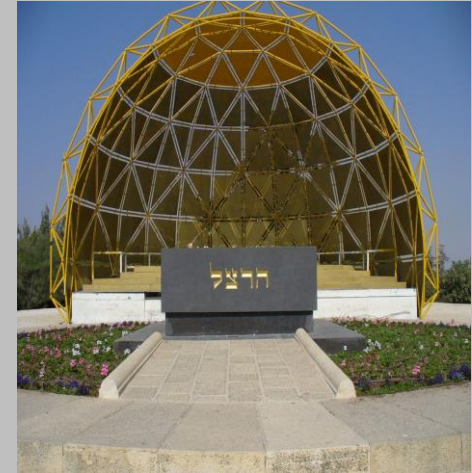
The Israel Museum

Comprising nearly 50,000 square meters and a six-acre sculpture garden, this complex features an impressive variety of collections from prehistoric archaeology to contemporary art. The children's wing is the most interactive section of this sprawling museum. There are special activities for kids during Jewish holidays and school vacations.



Herzl Museum

The new Herzl Museum includes a spectacular audio-visual encounter with the visionary of the Jewish State. The presentation provides a thought provoking 60 minute look into the Jewish world according to Herzl's insights. The visit to the museum allows one to be an active participant in understanding Herzl's bold aspirations and disappointments during his stormy personal journey. Through the encounter with Herzl's great achievements, the visitor senses himself a part of Herzl's enduring heritage.



The Supreme Court of Israel

The edifice housing the Supreme Court is widely acclaimed as the pinnacle of modern Israeli architecture. Like all public buildings in the capital, it is faced with distinctive Jerusalem stone.



Knesset (Parliament)

Free guided tours of Israel's Parliament include an explanation of the structure of the Israeli government and a look at the famous tapestries of Marc Chagall, which illustrate important moments in Jewish history.



Machane Yehuda Market

Jerusalem is in many ways a modern Western city, but those visitors wanting a raw whiff of true Middle Eastern life have only to walk to Machane Yehuda, better known to Jerusalemites as the shuk (market). Lining its two main aisles, which run between Agrippas and Jaffa, and the complex warren of smaller aisles between them, are dozens of stands, stalls, shops and small restaurants, offering a dizzying array of goods ranging from cleaning supplies to still-wriggling fish. The main attraction is, of course, the cornucopia of food, especially authentic Middle Eastern delicacies.



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
